

month include: Armchair Travel to the Italian countryside, Movie Matinee: *Under the Tuscan Sun*, and Dine In Lunch from Amorosa



Armstrong Elementary students joined the residents of George Derby Centre to commemorate the approaching 75th anniversary of the Netherlands liberation from Nazi occupation, by Canadian soldiers during the Second World War by planting 50 bulbs in George Derby's Tulip Tribute garden.

This special initiative from the Canadian Tulip Festival in Ottawa, the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the National Capital Commission and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, aims to plant approximately one million bulbs across the country to mark the final liberation that took place on May 5, 1945.

Birthstone of the Month - Turquoise

December's birthstone is the turquoise. Although found all over the world, it gets its name because it was prevalent in ancient Turkish culture. Turquoise was traded at Turkish bazaars to Venetian merchants, who brought it to Europe. The Aztecs mined turquoise in an area now known as New Mexico, and a significant amount of turquoise today comes from Arizona, California, and Nevada. The stones are most commonly pale blue with veins of brown or black running through them, but they can also be dark blue or green.



Flower of the Month - Daffodil Narcissus, more commonly known as the blooms in springtime. Its lovely, delicate its name comes from the Greek myth of

daffodil, is a beautiful flower that usually white petals and yellowish orange center make it a gardening favorite. Most believe Narcissus, a young man who was so taken by his own reflection in a pool of water that he fell in and drowned. In this story, a daffodil sprang up from the very spot where he had sat. Since the narcissus was often used for a medicine, others believe that the name is derived from the Greek word narke, which means "numbness."
